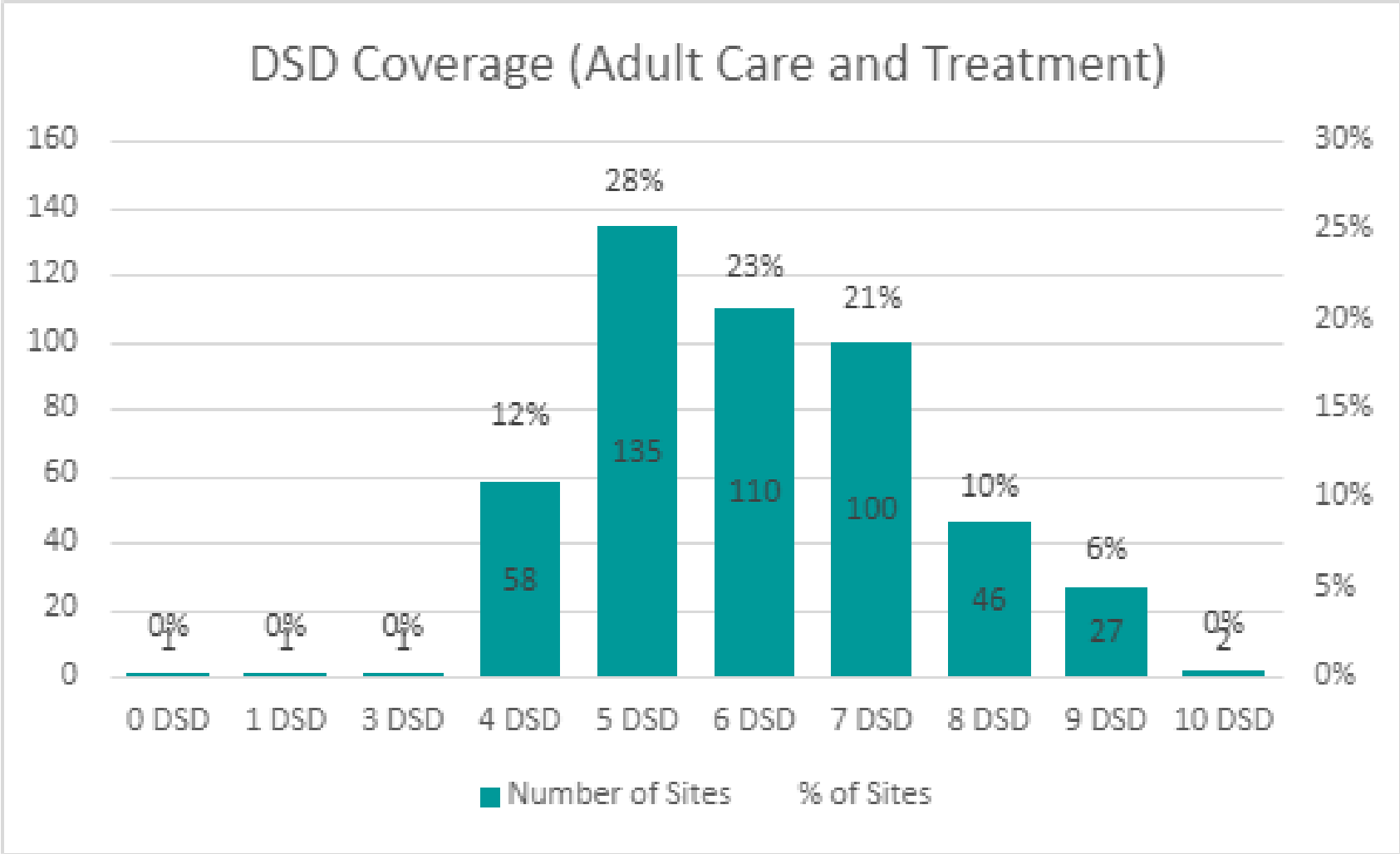

**All AJUDA-supported sites**

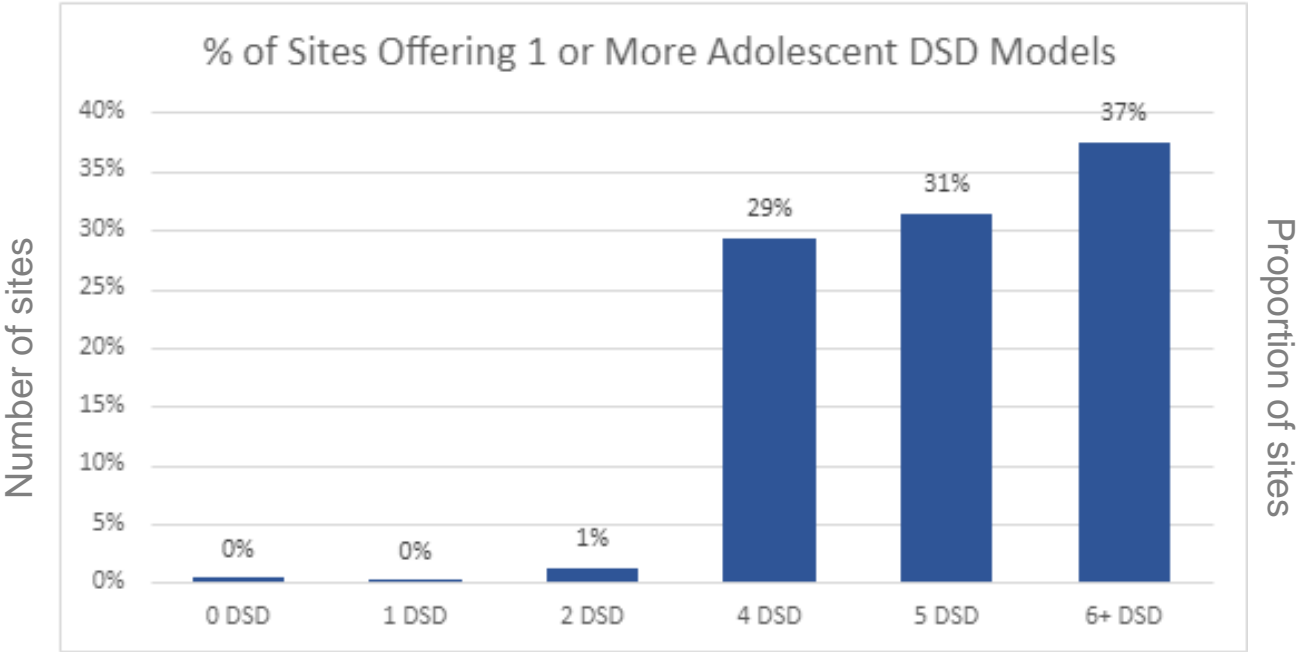
- >85% of sites have ≥5 DSD models available
- Estimated 88% of all TX\_CURR clients on ≥1 DSD model (Current MISAU target: 70%)
- FY21 Q1 TX\_MMD: 70%

## ARPA Proposal

- *Repair of Program Injury:* “Efforts to meet program needs that are increased by COVID-19 conditions”
- ARPA funds directed toward ensuring DSD quality and impact in setting of COVID
